## Talks tips

- ► It gets easier, but not easy
- ► Know your audience
- ▶ Don't go over time
- Start with the application
- ► Illustrations and figures ≫ words
- ► Fully explain it, or leave it out
- ► Think about what you like and dislike about others' talks
- ► It's risky to mimic another's style
- ▶ No need for an outline or "thank you" slide
  - But I like a summary, particularly with pictures
- Have something to drink on hand

- 1. Don't Put Words on Slides
- 2. Use Black Slides
- 3. Show Your Data
- 4. Don't Tell Jokes
- 5. Don't Take A Data Dump On Your Audience
- 6. Practice, Practice, Practice
- 7. Tell and Show
- 8. Finish When You Are Done, Preferably Sooner
- ▶ A Talk is not a Paper
